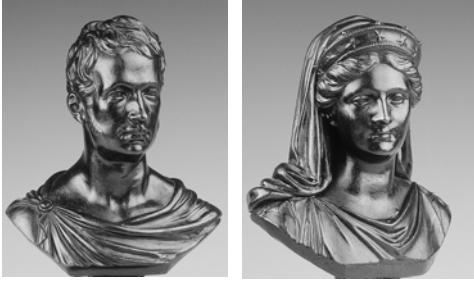




Hey Kids! Did you know that cast iron is used to make everything from frying pans to artwork to fine jewelry?
